AIMS

The breast cancer meeting in Modena started seven years ago as a Meet the Professor initiative to facilitate the discussion among recognized Experts and physicians involved in breast cancer management. Over the years, the number and the expertise of the attendees has increased as has the scientific content of the meeting. This seventh edition is now an international conference that will gather some of the top scientists and clinicians from all over the word. The Programme of the Conference includes lectures, round tables on topics that require a multifaceted approach, highlights from international meetings, debates on controversial items and clinical case discussions. 

Monica Boscolo Research Grant

The Scientific Committee will select the winner of the Monica Boscolo Research Grant. This Research Award is restricted to young Italian researchers (<40 years) who will carry out a research project at a foreign institution. The award is made for an amount up to € 24.000.

Unimore Award

The Scientific Committee will select young researchers (<40 years from any country) who have published in an international peer-reviewed journal, as the principal author, a manuscript reporting important clinical or biological advances in breast cancer. Prof. Conte and Prof. Hortobagyi will select the final winner which will be invited to present his/her study during the annual Conference. The Unimore Award consists of € 6.000.

Patrizia Rossi Merit Award

This award is rescricted to students of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia who have graduated in 2010/2011 with a graduation thesis on biological or clinical aspects of breast cancer. The award consists of \in 1.000.
