The breast cancer meeting in Modena started seven years ago as a Meet the Professor initiative to facilitate the discussion among recognized Experts and physicians involved in breast cancer management. Medical oncologists, breast surgeons, radiologists, pathologists and basic scientists interested in translational research are welcome to Modena to listen to breast cancer leaders and exchange experience in a friendly atmosphere.
